

St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Elementary School  
Dress Code for 2008-2009

All students at St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Elementary School wear uniforms. The uniform code is not set up to restrict student's individualism because we know a child's individualism and self-worth should not be related to one's clothes. Please remember that students represent St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Elementary School and any recent trend is not part of the uniform.

**Uniforms for boys**

**Pants:** true khaki **uniform** pants and shorts (no cargo, corduroy, carpenter or painter pants)

- Brown or black belts must be worn
- **Pre-K** must wear elastic pants and shorts
- **Kindergarten** has the option of wearing the elastic version, but must wear a belt if pants or shorts have belt loops.

**Shirts:** navy long or short sleeve polo shirts (collared and two or three buttons).

**Shoes/Socks:**

- Black or navy socks (**full length crew socks only**)
- Black or brown shoes (accent color white only). No boots, high tops, shoes with wheels, flip flops, sandals, jelly or croc type shoes.

**Uniforms for girls**

**Pre-Kindergarten through Fourth**

**Jumpers:** plaid jumper available at School Time in Slidell, LA.

- Girls must wear navy knit shorts under their jumper (shorts may not be visible)

**Shirts:** short or long sleeve white Peter Pan collared shirts or white or navy polo (collared and two or three button).

**Shoes/Socks:**

- White or navy blue socks (**full length crew or knee socks only**)
- Navy blue or solid white tights (in cold weather)
- Spandex-type leggings and sweatpants may not be worn
- Black or brown shoes (accent color white only). Shoes must closed toe and closed heel. No boots, high tops, shoes with wheels, flip flops, sandals, jelly or croc type shoes.

**OUTERWEAR**

**Jackets, sweaters and sweatshirts** worn in the school building over the uniform must be navy.

### Other

Girls may wear one earring in each ear. No dangling earrings (only studs that do not hang past the earlobes). Boys may not wear earrings. No other jewelry may be worn except Catholic religious items.

Hair bows and clips must match uniform colors (white, navy, light blue, gold or yellow). No hair extremes (extensions, wraps, color, beads, etc.).

No tattoos, body art or makeup. Girl's finger nail polish must be clear or light pink in color.

Label all clothing including hats, coats, jackets, sweaters, and gloves with your child's name.

PreK-3 and PreK-4 should bring an extra set of clothes in a large zip lock bag in case of accidents. Extra pair of clothes does not have to be a uniform.
